

FIREARMS, ALCOHOL, AND DRUGS POLICY

Many Odin's Warrior Tribe members and guests are still employed by the U.S. Military and/or the U.S. and/or local government and hold security clearances. Accordingly, unlawful activities at official Odin's Warrior Tribe events, which could adversely affect the livelihood and reputation of members of the group, and the group itself, or are inherently unsafe, are not allowed.

DRUGS: Odin's Warrior Tribe members and/or guests will not possess, or use, illegal drugs at any Odin's Warrior Tribe event. Illegal drug means any drug not legally obtained, which is illegal under federal and/or state law, is not legally obtainable in the state where the event is held, which is not lawfully prescribed, or which is not being used for a lawfully prescribed purpose. As a general rule, we do not support members using illegal drugs even privately.

FIREARMS: Individuals attending Odin's Warrior Tribe events may possess a firearm if that individual is not otherwise prohibited by law from possessing the firearm and if the possession of the firearm complies with the laws of the state where the event is located.

It is the responsibility of Odin's Warrior Tribe members and guests to understand and comply with all applicable Federal, state and local firearms laws and regulations, including laws authorizing or prohibiting concealed carry, at the event location.

Individuals attending Odin's Warrior Tribe events may not carry firearms on private property when prohibited by the owner of the property, or where posted as prohibited. If in doubt ask the property owner.

While Virginia law allows open carry for qualified individuals, concealed carry is preferable at Odin's Warrior Tribe events so as not to draw unwanted public attention to the event. Whether concealed or not, handguns are to remain holstered during Odin's Warrior Tribe events. Other firearms, such as a rifles or shot guns are not to be displayed in a public manner during Odin's Warrior Tribe events on public property, or on private property, except with the consent of the property owner. No firearms are to be left unattended at an Odin's Warrior Tribe event unless they are stored in a locked location such as in a locked gun case or in a locked vehicle.

Separate Firearms Safety Rules will be applicable for any Odin's Warrior Tribe event involving firearms training at a range or private facility.

FIREARMS AND ALCOHOL AND DRUGS: Alcohol and drugs do not mix with the carry of firearms. Under Virginia law for example, any person permitted to carry a concealed handgun, who is under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs while carrying such handgun in a public place, shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.

Odin's Warrior Tribe recommends that during events where drinking of alcohol is taking place, unless a person does not intend to drink, that they secure their firearm(s) in a locked location.
